

**City of Red Lake Falls**  
**Public Hearing**  
**January 27, 2025**  
**Minutes**

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Red Lake Falls, Red Lake County, Minnesota was duly held in the Council Chambers of said City on the 27th day of January, 2025.

The meeting was called to order at 6:03 p.m.

The purpose of the public hearing was for The City Council of the City of Red Lake Falls, Minnesota to consider a request from Red Lake Electric Cooperative requesting to vacate a portion of certain streets, avenues and alleyways as set forth below to build a new facility.

A proposed vacation of Adams Avenue SW, located northerly of the North line of International Drive and southerly of the South line of 7<sup>th</sup> Street SW, in Railroad Addition to the City of Red Lake Falls, MN;

AND

The alleyway located East of Block Twenty-three (23) and West of Block Thirteen (13) in Railroad Addition to the City of Red Lake Falls, MN;

AND

The alleyway located northerly of the North line of Lots Eight through Fourteen (8-14) of Block Thirteen (13) and southerly of the South line of Lots One through Seven (1-7) Block Thirteen (13), all in Railroad Addition to the City of Red Lake Falls, MN;

Reserving to the City an easement for utility purposes in the vacated alleyway, together with the right to install, maintain, repair, and replace said utilities, if necessary.

The meeting was open to public comments and questions. There were none.

Council discussed that the vacation would be contingent upon Red Lake Electrics approval of a building permit.

The meeting adjourned at 6.09 pm.
