Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a public hearing of the City Council of the City of Red Lake Falls, Red Lake County, Minnesota was duly held in the Council Chambers of said City on the 12th day of September, 2022.

The meeting was called to order at 6:01 p.m.

The purpose of the public hearing was to consider the Vacation Request by Altoz, Inc.

The property in question is Seventh Street SW located West of a line extended northerly from the Northwest corner of Lot 22, Block 38, Railroad Addition to Southwest corner of Lot 13, Block 39, Railroad Addition and located East of a line extended northerly from the northwest corner of Lot 13, Block 54, Railroad Addition to the Southwest corner of Lot 13, Block 53, Railroad Addition AND all of that certain alleyway located West of Lots 1 through 11, Block 54 Railroad Addition and East of Lots 12 and 13, Block 54, Railroad Addition to the City of Red Lake Falls, MN, to the extent the same had not been previously vacated, reserving unto the City of Red Lake Falls an easement for utility purposes in the vacated streets, together with the right to install, maintain, repair, and replace said utilities, as necessary.

The meeting was opened to public comments and questions. There were none.

Matzke moved, seconded by Ingraham, to recommend approval of the vacation request by Altoz, Inc.

On vote being taken, the motion was unanimously passed.
